

# Interview with Swaleh Naqvi Saheb

# Challenge of Human Development

Economic efforts should always be targeted toward providing a dignified living to the citizens of a country so they can live happily and participate in the national development. It is not the rising growth figures that benefit a country but the trickling down effect of national growth on the population that matter even more toward the creation of equality for all citizens and the eradication of poverty.

Pakistan's income distribution presents an unequal picture and gives birth to class disparity, poverty, poor human development in a way it delivers overall growth and development of the nation. Poverty is a serious threat for a country because it manifests itself in a complex web whose threads are interwoven with the issues of illiteracy, income distribution disparities, lack of access to facilities, defective polices, etc. The country needs a multidimensional solution to address all issues for removing poverty and need from our midst.

The country's best known banker and philanthropist Agha Hasan Abedi recognized this situation and used his Group and bank's resources to the Infaq Foundation some thirty six years ago. During this period the foundation has been associated with several institutes/individuals providing monetary and material help and advisory support where called upon to do so. Notable among these are SIUT, Shaukat Khanum Hospital, NICVD, Marie Adelaide, LRBT Eye Care, GIK Institute of Technology, Orangi Pilot Project, Ida Rieu, Lady Dufferin, Behbud and others.

The most viable solution to attack poverty and its evils is human development, as humans are the true assets of any nation and all efforts are reflected in the state of their wellbeing. Distribution of resources and opportunities, inequality, poverty alleviation, human development are the key areas that need to be addressed. We can thereby achieve fair and equitable distribution of national wealth and remove poverty and inequality of income as well as opportunity from our midst.

INFAQ Foundation acquired 72 acres of land in the poorest of the poor localities of Korangi in Lalabad to set up a Centre for Development of Social Services that today includes Korangi Academy, Intermediate College for boys and girls and for the empowerment of women, an Elementary College, Teachers Training Centre. Vocational Training Centre in collaboration with the global SOS Villages. A well-equipped Medical OPD Clinic, a Multi-Purpose Hall, sports grounds and exquisite greenery embellish the Centre.

Needless to say the arrangement for such high class facilities made available to the financially challenged students and families is impossible without the support of the more fortunate segments of the community. That is why an aggressive Fund Raising Drive in CDSS is in motion for about four years. It was kicked off at Sheraton Hotel (now renamed Movenpick Hotel) with some 500 guests present from the Corporate Sector. On the advice of Syed Salahuddin Haider of 21st Century a grand function was held by Co-Sponsor 21ST Century Club and CDSS to convince the participants of our aims and objectives.

The Fund Raising Committee is highly grateful to all donors, particularly Banks, Financial groups for their generous contribution and promises for ongoing support to CDSS in its Fund Raising efforts. May Allah bless them all with long life and continued good fortune.





# Ambitious Students at IETC and committed Librarian

We visited the Community Library at CDSS with a desire to know the utility of this library and talked to students who were busy in their studies.

**Ms. Sumera Ayaz** from Sherpao Colony studies at Korangi Academy is a member of a large family with seven siblings with two sisters in laws and two nephews and her parents. In total they are 12 members in one household. Her father is a time keeper at a private company and her mother is a house wife.

Sumera Ayaz is preparing for her second year pre-medical examination and is confident to get admission at some leading medical college as she feels that the teachers and other facilities are one of the best in the city.

**Ms. Iman Fatima** also plans to study medicine after qualifying with flying colors from Korangi Academy. Like Sumera she also has 7 siblings and they face lot of hardships because of limited resources and other challenges. She feels very privileged that such facility is arranged at CDSS where they get not only good education, food, training for her mother and also medical facilities for the entire family.

**Ms. Anila Amin** is the librarian at the Community library who completed her BA Degree privately and now serving as the librarian and feels very privileged that she is now contributing in educating children of this area. Ms. Anila has two brother and six sisters and live with her mother.

## Health Care by Pervez Igbal

You may be aware that there are several unique features at CDSS in addition to Korangi Academy, which is serving as one of the leading education centers in Karachi. Healthcare Center is taking care of a large community in the adjoining areas of CDSS.

It was such a pleasant experience to see the doctors and paramedic staff attending people including the parents of students at Korangi Academy with utmost attention and empathy.

Dr. Tabasum Jabeen & Dr Hameeda are responsible to manage the clinic at CDSS. This clinic performs the full annual medical checkup for all students to ensure that they remain healthy and attend the full academic year without any interruptions due to health issues. This clinic provides following role:

- CBC +HB + Eyesight tests + height/weight for growth monitoring
- · Vaccinations as per the requirement of each individual including BCG & Polio.

Most common complaints from area residents are skin diseases due to poor hygiene and anemic patients as a result of malnutrition. Cases of asthma are also common as a result of high level of pollution in this area.

Only Rs. 10 is charged to patients as dignity fee to cover consultation/ high quality medicines as well as medical tests as per requirement. The treatment is carried till the patient is fully recovered to live a normal life.

The doctors suggested that if one standby ambulance is available at the facility it could be useful to meet critical emergency cases, as there were incidents that they used their personal cars to transfer the critical patients to bigger hospitals. However, this is not recommended as it is very inconvenient for patients.

The facility of Ultrasound and dental treatment is planned for the benefit of patients who can't afford to get this facility on payment outside the CDSS premises. We request the kind hearted donors and philanthropists to come forward and help us achieve this target in the year 2017 and bring comfort the lives of people living in this disadvantaged area.

# CDSS PROJECTS

#### **About CDSS**

INFAQ Foundation had purchased a plot of about 100 acres from Karachi Development Authority in 1985 for development of Social Services (CDSS) in 2001. It was registered under the Society Act of 1860. The Governing Body is the primary policy making forum of CDSS has appointed a Management Committee to supervise the day to day management of the Korangi Projects.

The objectives of this intiative are to promote community welfare programs including community development, provide quality education and medical aid to the poor, and support meritorious students for higher studies.

## Korangi Academy (KA)

Korangi Academy was established in 2001 to impart quality education and enhance faculties of the talented and deserving children of deprived families. This three-storey, elegantly designed and custom-built educational complex has a total covered area of 94,390 sq. ft. It has well-equipped science labs, computer labs and audio visual aid labs, as well as a well-maintained library. Besides hockey/cricket/football fields, canteen & cafeteria, there is also a modern Multipurpose Hall with a capacity to accommodate around 1,000 people.

# Infaq Education & Training Centre (IETC)

This girls' only institute aims to provide quality informal and formal education through its Senior Girls' School, Intermediate Girls' College, Graduate Classes and Elementary Teachers' Training. The courses offered by IETC are registered with Education & Literacy Department of Sindh.

## Infaq Community Healthcare Centre (ICHC)

ICHC was established in 2001 to provide healthcare services to students of CDSS projects and their families. It has now grown into a fully-functional primary healthcare centre, catering to the needs of the surrounding population. Around 300 patients visit the ICHC daily who avail these services for a token fee of Rs. 10.

## Craft Training & Adult Literacy Centre (CTALC)

CTALC was formed by CDSS and is being managed by Behbud Association Karachi Since November 2002. This centre aims to empower the community girls around the CDSS through acquiring technical/vocational skills. CDSS is responsible to run this centre besides providing building and equipment, while Behbud, with its vast experience in running women empowerment projects, provides expertise and management.

# SOS Technical Training Institute (CDSS Campus)

SOS Technical Training Institute is a joint venture of SOS Children's Villages of Sindh and INFAQ Foundation. INFAQ is responsible to bear the cost of building, equipment, furniture, fixtures and training aids for the Institute, while SOS Children's Villages of Sindh provides running expenses to manage the Institute as a social welfare project.

# **Boys Hostel**

KA has the facility of a full fledged hostel. The ORP students live in it throughout the academic session at no cost.

Additionally, the students appearing in Boards examinations are provided hostel facility for 4 months before the examination. This facility allows the students to prepare for the examination with concentration which is not available to them in their domestic environment. The hostel is closely supervised by wardens.

# INFAQ Graduate Institute for Teachers Education – IGITE

IGITE offers bachelor programme in Education (B.Ed.). It aims to make a positive contribution to the Government's Policy of teachers' development to improve the standard of education by providing qualified and trained teachers to the schools system in Pakistan. The institute is equipped with purpose-built infrastructure, computer lab and library to provide opportunities to trainee teachers in enhancing their competence and knowledge. Admissions are given on priority basis to residents of Malir, Landhi and Korangi and other areas to facilitate people belonging to these areas to receive high class education near their home. Presently 13 female students, mostly from low income class are studying in IGITE on concessional tuition fees.
